

MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

Plaintiffs filed their initial Complaint for Visitation on February 25, 2025. Since that time there has been newly discovered evidence that cause the Plaintiff's concern about the minor child while he is under Defendant's care. The minor child was removed temporarily from Defendant's care and placed with Plaintiffs because of concerns, but has since returned. However, many of the concerns may still exist and should be investigated by this Court. Plaintiffs now seek leave of court pursuant to Civ.R.15(A) to amend their Complaint due to the newly discovered evidence. Pursuant to Civ.R. 15(A), "A party may amend its pleading once as a matter of course within twenty-eight days after serving it or, if the pleading is one to which a responsive pleading is required within twenty-eight days after service of a responsive pleading or twenty-eight days after service of a motion under Civ. R. 12(B), (E), or (F), whichever is earlier." Civ.R. 15(A). Furthermore, "The court shall freely give leave when justice so requires." Civ.R. 15(A).

Plaintiffs have not been served with a pleading responsive to the initial complaint. Plaintiffs now seek leave of court to amend their Complaint to add a claim to be named the legal custodians of the minor child, should this Court deem fit. Further, no prejudice would occur to Defendant if Plaintiffs were permitted to amend their Complaint and add the additional claim. Furthermore, leave to plead should be freely given when justice so requires. As this information was not previously available and such amendment is in the best interest of the minor child, Plaintiffs should be permitted to amend their Complaint to assert all claims available to them in this matter.

Wherefore, Plaintiffs respectfully pray that this Court GRANT the Motion for Leave to File an Amended Complaint.

MAGISTRATE ORDER WITH INSTRUCTIONS

This matter was before the Court for an Oral Temporary Orders Hearing on June 9, 2025. The parties appeared with their counsel. Plaintiffs, Jeffrey and Beth Garner, were represented by Attorney Abbey M. Becca. Defendant, Justine Knight, was represented by Attorney Kelsi Robinson. The Guardian ad Litem, Kristina Walkowicz, was also present. The GAL provided an oral report and summary of her investigation. Following discussions with the Court, Counsel, and the GAL, the following orders and agreements were reached with regard to grandparent visitation time with the minor child,

 Plaintiffs, Jeff and Beth Garner, shall have visitation with the minor child, Bentley, every-other-Saturday beginning June 14, 2025. The days in June shall be for four (4) hours, and beginning in July the visitation shall be for eight (8) hours. Notwithstanding, the parties have adjusted the schedule and agree to the following days/times in June and July.

Bentley T. Letourneau (DOB: 7/20/2010). The Court finds the following orders to be in the best interest of the minor child. Accordingly, the Court hereby Orders as follows:

 Plaintiffs, Jeff and Beth Garner, shall have visitation with the minor child on Saturday, June 14, 2025 and Saturday, June 21, 2025, from 4:00 p.m. through

8:00 p.m.

 Plaintiff's, Jeff and Beth Garner, shall have visitation with the minor child on Sunday, July 13, 2025 and Sunday, July 27, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. through 6:00 p.m.

4. Defendant, Justine Knight, shall make the child available for the visitations.

Unless the parties otherwise agree, in writing, Plaintiffs shall pick up and drop off the minor child outside of Mother's apartment building on the side of the stairs. Plaintiffs will stay in their vehicle for the exchange, and Mother shall remain in her apartment.

At all times, both at exchanges or in public places, the parties shall remain civil and respectful of each other. There shall be no arguing, threatening, or name-

calling.

Neither party shall discuss this case, the documents filed in this case, or information disclosed by the Guardian ad Litem with the minor child of this matter. Further, neither party shall attempt to discuss this case at the exchanges or in the presence of the minor child.

This matter is scheduled for an in camera interview on August 4, 2025 at 2:00 p.m. Defendant, Justine Knight, shall ensure the child's attendance.

 This matter is further scheduled for a Status Hearing on August 4, 2025 at 2:30 p.m. All parties shall be present and appear.
